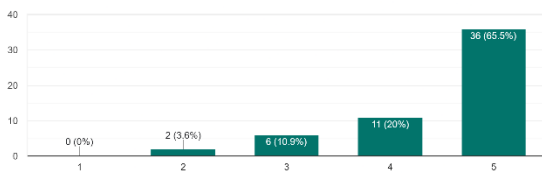
Forward

The information contained herein is an automated summary analysis conducted by Google forms. This was arrived at by generating a google forms survey located at: https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSfxtmtVhgwkfluv9U5dnV-ZDutk5Jp8cKs5lrGP-oz7wgTDA/viewform?vc=0&c=0&w=1&flr=0&usp=mail_form_link, which was then used as a tool to transcribe all data received on paper forms (or received via e-mail). This was the easiest way to collect the information electronically for future data analysis.

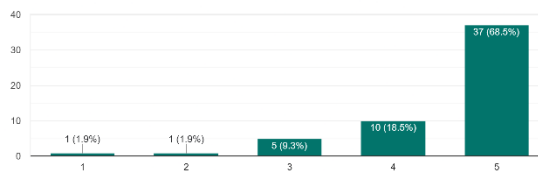

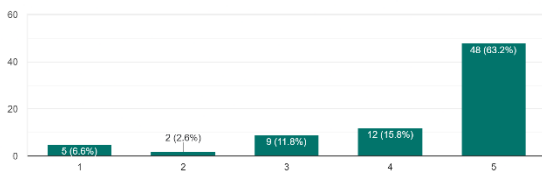
1. Thursday's Coffee Hour

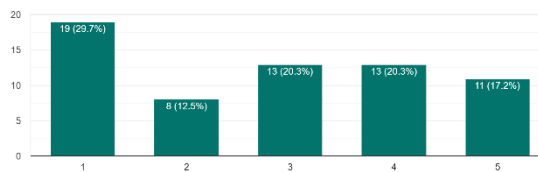
2. Friday's Coffee Hour

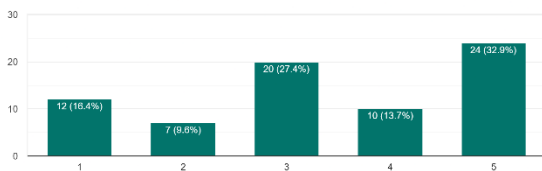
3. Anytime Lunch

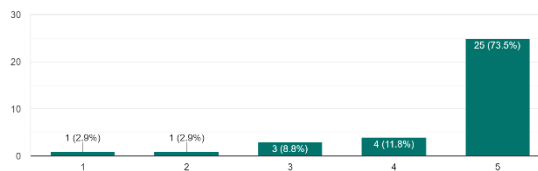
4. Saturday's Breakfast

- Need tables in shade for food trucks (benches at least).

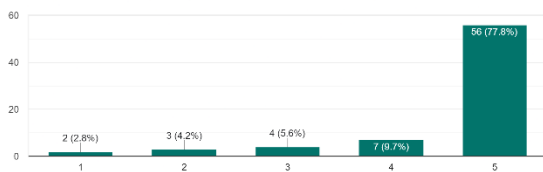
- Burritos too small

- Ladies Lunch should include a fabulous dessert or at least a brownie. Although I do drink alcohol, I would prefer dessert to wine

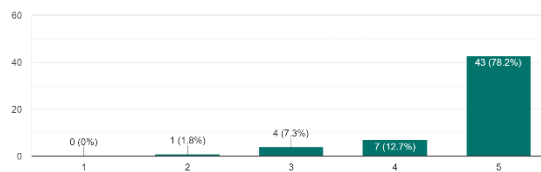
- A non-dairy option for Ice Cream social like Italian Ice pops from Sam's Club. Also, maybe some toppings for the Ice cream

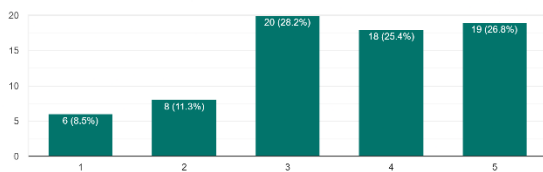
7. Wednesday Evening's Entertainment

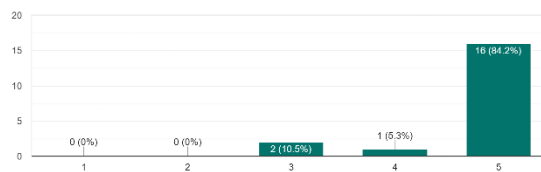
8. Thursday Evening's Card Bingo

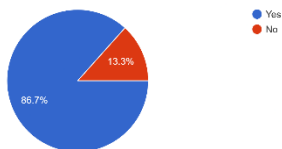
Suggestions related to Entertainment (32 responses)

- Wed - Music too loud Fri - Could not understand singer

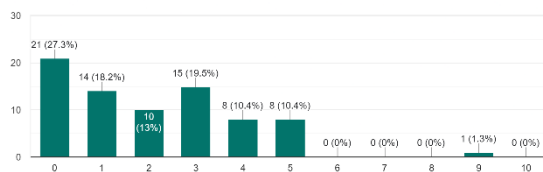
- Card bingo (?): Prizes not necessary Just play for fun and social interaction.

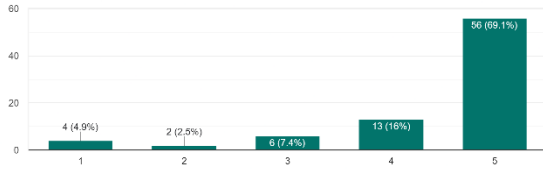
Suggestions related to Vendors and/or Seminars (33 responses)

- None on topic that we needed information

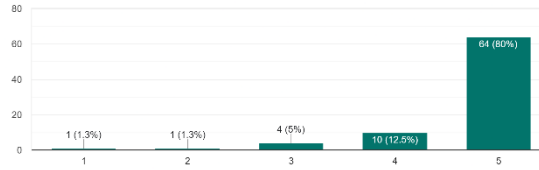
- Find more effective ways to get volunteers

Put a 15-20 min gap between seminars so the next presenter isn't setting up while another presenter is finishing. That happened twice and one had audio equipment he was testing and talking to people with him. Also, very rude and distracting.

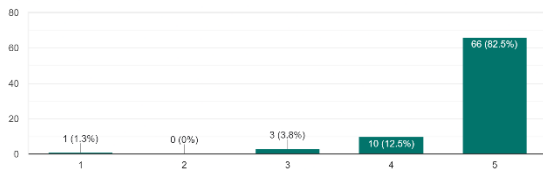
13. How Satisfied are you with the site where you were parked?

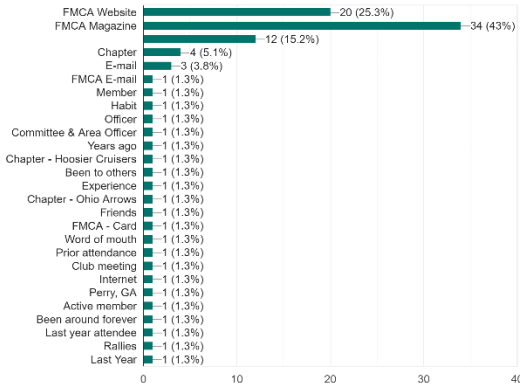
Suggestions related to Parking and/or Registration (29 responses)

- Either move venues closer to parking or coaches closer to venues
- ??? From Moose lot #16; bldg 1&2 too great a challenge to shuttle effectively.
- Parking and registration were very well prepared and the process went quick
- Don't appreciate having to pick up after other people's dogs on the last day here at our site
- Arrived early, parked ourselves
- 13 - Handicapped parking was too far from the entertainment pavilion
- Parking was far away - would like closer parking!
- Parking crew was outstanding!
- The golf cart shuttles worked very well and we definitely appreciated transportation! Thank you Volunteers.
- Super!
- Great Job!
- Parking too far away from activity. If it is a rainy week, it would be bad.
- I rated 4 on our site because we were on #4 in moose. We were to have 50A electric but only could get 30A Also, it was never suggested to bring extra water hose so we never water hook-up since we didn't have long enough hose to connect to water. We had paid for 50A full hook-up.
- Registration: 5+ Awesome location where we were parked.
- Site needed to be mowed; Mower came through an hour after we parked and mowed all around us and but grass at coach was 12 inches high (VN section). Too far from activities
- We are handicap & volunteers. Parking out by fence where we came in. Grass was too high for handicap walking. Too far from main building
- The shuttle drivers were all so nice and friendly. The women and men were the best ever.
- Handicapped need to be parked closer to the activities. Was there a need to park rigs so close? There seemed to be plenty of spaces to park. We weren't on the Volunteer list again, but we worked it out.

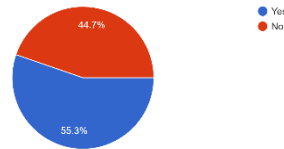
- Had sulfur smell in water
- The person helping park the coach put himself in a dangerous situation. He was next to the coach, holding the mirror mount, and telling me to turn the coach towards him. I had on wheel in a divit, and was not going to accelerate into him. He was adamant about turning towards him, while I did not want to ruin his day nor start an argument. For safety reasons, the parking crew should not stand behind the coach (the fellow in the rear did this and was visible in the mirror) and the person in the front should be at least three feet away from the coach to prevent any accidents. I would recommend that you get someone with a cdl to write instructions for the parking crew, highlighting all safety issues! Registration was cramped.
- There were plenty of sites, although we were packed in tight at our location. Our car was parked away from us
- The shuttle service was very good
- Not with all chapter. It would be great if we could all be together as a chapter instead of being in 4 areas. It makes it harder to recruit people or for new recruits to stop by. This is why I rated it low.

- Our site was pretty far from the main road. I have a hard time walking far - I would have liked to be closer to where the shuttles were running We can't seem to get to registration by 4 on Wednesday. It would be nice if it was open at the evening event or maybe just a short time before. Without it, you don't have a way to wear your name tag.
- When we arrived, the two "jerks" on the parking crew were upset because we had not received our window placard (not our fault). They told us to park on the grass and they would get back to us. Meanwhile, as they were arguing and waving their arms and parking no one (12 units were backed up waiting) we found this beautiful site in the shade, but they said we could not park there. Parking experience was lousy. Then we met Fuzzy and he found us a site. The ladies at registration were very pleasant and understanding, but the two guys at the gate should not be treating people this way. If we had not prepaid for the rally, or could have gotten our money back we would have left the rally. If any first timers were treated like we were, they would never come back.

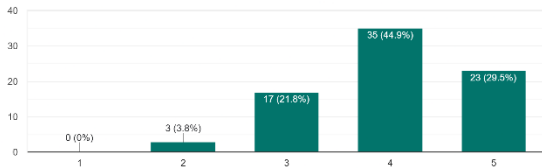

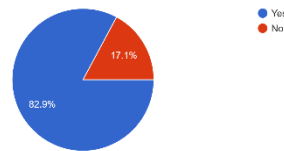


Overall GLAMARAMA Responses

- The food trucks were not very reliable and not enough variety. Need more women's things from the vendors.
- More informational sessions, not just "sales" pitches (i.e. tire care, exterior care, driving tips, pros & cons of RV types)
- My wife and I have organized events and understand that there are some things that are outside of your control, such as the Saturday breakfast. However, Darke county is too long of a ride for us (500+ miles) to try this venue again. Goshen is nice because it is close to Elkhart. We understand that there are issues with the Goshen fair-ground, but my wife and I had a better time there than in Darke. Regarding the first timers meeting: Whenever we go to a rally at a new venue, we attend the first timers meeting. Usually, the subjects that are covered are not repeated at the opening ceremonies. Since the same materials were covered, why was the first timers meeting held?
- There are always suggestions to make rally experiences better, but overall, we enjoyed ourselves and appreciate your efforts. The shuttles were especially helpful. It would've been difficult for us without them.
- Not our best venue; hard to get to. Did our Ohio Chapters support it? We did it for them! Games - Debbie was fabulous job with all the games and then prizes presented at entertainment! Great!
- Probably not return - way too far to events from parking
- Maybe return to Darke Have the shuttle service go to official stops - not just pickup. Had lots of people waiting and no shuttles because they would stop 1/2 way to pickup and get "walkers" and not come get those at shuttle stops.
- Maybe will return. Shuttle service was excellent! If GLAMA returns to Darke County Fairgrounds, must have adequate shuttle service . Thanks for FMCA active shooter Event card
- The book was hard to follow. You had to keep leafing through pages to see what was happening (seminars, games, crafts, etc.) I'm not sure how we get attendance up. I would maybe e-mail a questionnaire to all to see what is important to them in/for a regional rally (i.e. entertainment, vendors, food, socialization, location; cost is always a big one. Maybe even get suggestions of places that can

hold 300 - 500 RVs. Is there a reason none of the minstrels were here? That would have added to our numbers. They do need to play softer during coffee hour so we can chat and hear.

- Yes - will return if it is better organized Send out text blasts with daily updates & reminders Solicit more vendors and don't put them in a destination building but rather in a place where people are going to visit anyway.
